

RESOLUTION NO. 2022- 04

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO THE TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVE PROGRAM (TAP) FUNDED THROUGH OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (ODOT) FOR REPLACEMENT OF SIDEWALKS AND TRAFFIC SIGNAL UPGRADES ALONG MAIN STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, TAP provides funds to local governments through ODOT for projects that enhance the transportation experience by improving the cultural, aesthetic, and environmental aspects of a Municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Village has been invited by ODOT to participate in the application process; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Centerburg, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to submit an application to TAP.

SECTION 2. Upon award, the funds will be used for pedestrian improvements along Main Street as outlined on the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 3. The immediate operation of the provisions of this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the Village of Centerburg. Said emergency being the need to file application with ODOT by the application deadline.

**WHEREFORE**, this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency and shall take effect and be in force on the earliest date allowed by law from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
