

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-02

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2013-16 REVISING THE CONTRACT PRICE FOR VITITOE CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR WORK ON THE WASTEWATER RECLAMATION FACILITY PROJECT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has determined it appropriate and necessary to proceed with the New Water Reclamation Facility Project (“WRF Project”); and

WHEREAS, Council has sought and been awarded funding to assist in the cost of completing the WRF Project with a total projected cost of \$6,612,350.15; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator solicited bids for construction of the WRF Project in conformance with Ordinance 2013-07, Ordinance 2013-14, and the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, a contract was awarded to Vititoe Construction, Inc. pursuant to Ordinance 2013-16; and

WHEREAS, the Village and Vititoe Construction, Inc. have agreed to a Change Order to said Contract requiring the approval of Counsel;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Centerburg, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That upon final approval by the Ohio EPA Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance, the Village Administrator and/or Mayor are hereby authorized to approve a change order for the Contracts with Vititoe Construction, Inc. whereby the total Contract Price with Vititoe Construction, Inc. of Ostrander, Ohio at a cost not to exceed \$1,725,305.15, shall be revised and amended as follows:

Section 2: That Council authorized the Village Administrator and/or Mayor to execute a Change Order and related documents to resolve all matters in conformance with the REVISED CONTRACT amount with Vititoe Construction, Inc. subject to the approval of the Village Solicitor, Village Engineer and the Ohio EPA Division of Environmental and Financial Assistance.
