ORDINANCE 2013-10

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE PARTICIPATION IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE HARTFORD AVENUE WATERLINE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village has submitted a request to the State of Ohio to receive Issue 1 funding for the construction of the Hartford Avenue Waterline, and

WHEREAS, the Village has been granted an interest-free loan through the Ohio Public Works Commission of Issue 1 funds in the amount of \$86,913 and financial assistance in the form of a grant in the amount of \$260,739 pursuant to a Project Grant/Loan Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Centerburg, Knox County, Ohio as follows:

- <u>Section 1</u>: That the Village Administrator is authorized to enter into and execute the Project Grant/Loan Agreement with the Ohio Public Works Commission for funding of the **Hartford Avenue Waterline** as is more fully set forth in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein, also known as "Project Number CQ19Q/CQ20Q."
- Section 2: That the Clerk/Treasurer is authorized to execute and enter into the promissory note for the loan amount of \$86,913 at 0% interest with the Ohio Public Works Commission pursuant to the Project Grant/Loan Agreement.
- Section 3: That either the Village Administrator or the Clerk/Treasurer is authorized to execute any documents necessary for receipt of grant funds in the amount of \$260,739 from the Ohio Public Works Commission.
- Section 4: That either the Village Administrator or Clerk/Treasurer is hereby authorized to execute any and all additional documents as may be necessary for the attainment and repayment of the Issue 1 loan.
- Section 5: That the Village Engineer, as Project Manager, is hereby authorized to execute the Request to Proceed and any additional documents that need to be executed by the Project Manager as may be necessary for the completion of the Hartford Avenue Waterline.
- Section 6: That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare by providing for the necessary funding to make required repairs to the Village infrastructure.
