ORDINANCE 2023-36

TO CONTRACT FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES BETWEEN THE VILLAGE AND KNOX COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AND TO AUTHORIZE THE FISCAL OFFICER TO AMEND THE 2024 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS ACCORDINGLY AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has determined that police patrols and consistent law enforcement presence are appropriate within the Village, which is further supported by passage of the Police Levy by the Village residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Centerburg, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Village authorizes the Mayor, Village Solicitor, and Village Administrator to execute such contract and any other documents necessary to carry out the intent of this Ordinance for law enforcement services from the Knox County Sheriff's Department within the Village as set forth in the Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. That the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make any necessary amendments to the 2024 Village Budgets and Appropriations to the extent necessary to reflect the total amount of the additional payments as authorized in Section 1 above.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to provide for the immediate and continued law enforcement services to residents of the Village, as a necessary public service provided to Village residents.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
