

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-02

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CLERK TREASURER TO PAY VILLAGE UTILITY SUPERINTENDENT POSITION FOR ACCRUED VACATION PAY AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village Utility Superintendent has accrued significant amounts of vacation pay in excess of eighty (80) hours, the maximum allowance of vacation that can be carried over by a Village employee from year to year;

WHEREAS, the Village Utility Superintendent did not have sufficient flexibility to schedule vacation given the severe winter season in 2014-2015;

WHEREAS, Council has considered that the Village Utility Superintendent, when he did take leave, used compensatory time, instead of vacation pay, which would result in unfairness to the employee if he had to forfeit any vacation leave;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the Village of Centerburg, Knox County, Ohio:

Section 1: That the Clerk Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the Village Utility Superintendent for all vacation hours accrued as of March 31, 2015 in excess of eighty (80) hours to compensate him for leave time accrued that he was unable to take due to his dedicated service to the Village.

Section 2: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare to ensure that the Village Utility Superintendent is timely and fairly compensated for his service to the Village.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution is declared an emergency and shall take effect immediately and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
