

ORDINANCE 2017-06

TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND/OR CLERK TREASURER TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY, CASUALTY, AND GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF CENTERBURG AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Property and hazard insurance coverage on Village property is a necessary aspect of the operation of the Village; and

WHEREAS, general liability insurance coverage for officers and agents of the Village is also desirable;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Centerburg, Knox County, Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That the Village Administrator and/or Clerk-Treasurer are hereby authorized to expend up to \$19,746.00 to acquire insurance coverage on terms and conditions as quoted in the proposal provided by the joint self-insurance pool known as THE OHIO PLAN, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked "Exhibit A".

WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the earliest date allowed by law.
