

RESOLUTION 2020-12

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT APPLICATIONS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND/OR LOCAL TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

WHEREAS, the Village of Centerburg is planning to make capital improvements to South Hartford Avenue.

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of Centerburg:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

Section 2: The Village Administrator is further authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

Section 3: This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare to ensure that the Village Administrator can obtain grants for Village improvements.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution is declared an emergency and shall take effect immediately and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
