

ORDINANCE 2014- 03

TO AUTHORIZE THE CLERK TREASURER
TO AMEND THE BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS FOR 2013
REGARDING THE SHERIFF'S CONTRACT
AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council is employing three representatives from the Knox County Sheriff's Office to engage in such specific law enforcement services through its Contract with the Knox County Sheriff's Office; and

WHEREAS, Council has received a revised estimate from the Knox County Sheriff's Office of the projected costs of said contract through 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Centerburg, Ohio:

Section 1. That the Mayor, Village Solicitor, and Village Administrator are hereby authorized to enter into a revised Contract for Law Enforcement Services reflecting an increase in contract price for 2013 from \$185,400 to \$189,000 per the estimates received from the Knox County Sheriff's Office.

Section 2. That the Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to make any necessary amendments to the 2013 Budget per Ordinance 2012-10 and the Appropriations for 2013 per Ordinance 2012-16 to the extent necessary to reflect the total amount of the additional payments as authorized in Section 1 above.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure to provide for the immediate and continued law enforcement services to residents of the Village, as a necessary public service provided to Village residents.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage.
