ORDINANCE 2015-07

TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND/OR CLERK TREASURER TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY, CASUALTY AND GENERAL LIABILITY INSURANCE FOR THE VILLAGE

WHEREAS, property and hazard insurance coverage on Village property is a necessary aspect of the operation of the Village; and WHEREAS, general liability insurance coverage for officers and agents of the Village is also desirable; NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of Centerburg, Knox County, Ohio as follows: Section 1: That the Village Administrator and/or Clerk Treasurer are hereby authorized to expend up to \$ to acquire insurance coverage on terms and conditions as quoted in the proposal provided by the joint self-insurance pool known as the Ohio Plan, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked as "Exhibit A." Section 2: The Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare for the purpose of providing continued asset and liability protection to the Village. WHEREFORE, this Ordinance is declared an emergency and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
