

ORDINANCE 2018-04

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE A POLICE CRUISER AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CLERK TREASURER TO AMEND THE 2018 BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS TO ACCOUNT FOR THE PURCHASE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village is in need of a new police cruiser to replace a police cruiser that can no longer be repaired.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Centerburg, Ohio:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is authorized to purchase a police cruiser in an amount not to exceed \$31,000.00;

Section 2: That the Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to make any necessary amendments to the 2018 Budgets per Ordinance 2017-10 and the Appropriations for 2018 per Ordinance 2017-22 to the extent necessary to reflect the total amount of the additional payments as authorized in Section 1 above;

Section 3. Council declares this to be an emergency measure, such emergency arising out of the need to provide adequate resources to the Village safety officers.

WHEREFORE, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from the date of its passage.
