ORDINANCE NO. 2017-<u>04</u>

TO ACCEPT THE ANNEXATION INTO THE VILLAGE OF CENTERBURG OF CERTAIN TERRITORY IN HILLIAR TOWNSHIP CONTAINING 4.000 ACRES, MORE OR LESS, KNOWN AS 4301 WHITE ROAD, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a petition for annexation into the Village of Centerburg of certain territory of approximately 4.000 acres, more or less, in Hilliar Township and described in Exhibit "A" attached to this Ordinance and made a part hereof (the "Property"), was duly filed with the Knox County Commissioners by Thomas F. Schmitt, Esq. as Agent for Donald R. James and Terrie L. James (the "James"), as the owners of the Property; and

WHEREAS, the petition was duly considered and by Resolution 75-2017, approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Knox County, Ohio on 24 January 2017; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners certified a transcript of the proceedings in connection with said annexation with the map, petition and resolution to the Clerk of Council of the Village of Centerburg who received the same on 27 January, 2017; and

WHEREAS, sixty (60) days from the date of the delivery of such annexation documents have now lapsed in accordance with Section 709.04 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to declare an emergency to preserve the public health, safety and welfare by immediately providing sanitary sewer and other similar services to the property without further delay.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERBURG, OHIO:

- Section 1. That the annexation of certain territory adjacent to the Village of Centerburg and approved by the Board of County Commissioners of Knox County, Ohio in Resolution 75-2017 on January 24, 2017, be, and the same is hereby accepted.
- Section 2. That the Clerk of Council be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make copies of this Ordinance and the transcript of proceedings of the Board of County Commissioners relating thereto with appropriate certificate as to the correctness thereof and forthwith deliver the same in accordance with the provisions Chapter 709 of the Revised Code and, thereafter, to provide such notices as are required by Chapter 709 of the Revised Code.

Section 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in this Village, by providing a necessary sanitary sewer and other utility service.
