

**ORDINANCE 2021- 10**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PURCHASE A LAW ENFORCEMENT VEHICLE AND EQUIPMENT AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Village is in need of a new police cruiser to replace a 2016 model.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Centerburg, Ohio:

Section 1: The Village Administrator is authorized to purchase a law enforcement vehicle in an amount not to exceed \$33,000;

Section 2: The Village Administrator is authorized to upfit equipment on the law enforcement vehicle in an amount not to exceed \$10000;

Section 3. That the Clerk-Treasurer is hereby authorized to make any necessary amendments to the 2021 Budgets per Ordinance 2020-08 and the Appropriations for 2021 per Ordinance 2020-25 to the extent necessary to reflect the total amount of the additional payments as authorized in Sections 1 and 2 above;

Section 4. Council declares this to be an emergency measure, such emergency arising out of the need to provide adequate resources to the Village safety officers.

**WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from the date of its passage.
