ORDINANCE 2019-<u>04</u>

TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2018-24 TO REVISE SECTION 5 REGARDING PAY INCREASE FOR APPROVED LICENCES/CERTIFICATION FOR EMPLOYEES OF THE VILLAGE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed a wage, salary and benefits of Village employees; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined it appropriate to revise Section 5 of Ordinance 2018-24 regarding pay increases for Village employees that achieve certain licenses/certifications in conformance with Village Codified Ordinance Section 145.23; and

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of Centerburg as follows:

Section 1: That Section 5 of Ordinance 2018-24 be amended in its entirety to read as follows:

Section 5. That pursuant to Codified Ordinance §145.23, Council approves the following list of Approved License/Certifications and a one-time corresponding pay increase for each approved certification or license obtained by Employees during the 2019 calendar year. Pay increases for license/certifications received before the passage of this Ordinance are already incorporated in to the hourly rates for said employees.

Approved License/Certification	Pay Increase
Wastewater Treatment Class I	\$1.00/hour
Wastewater Treatment Class II	\$1.60/hour

Section 2. That all other provisions of Ordinance 2018-24 shall remain unchanged.

<u>Section 3.</u> That this Ordinance is determined to be an emergency arising out of the necessity to provide timely increases in compensation to the employees of the Village of Centerburg.
