ORDINANCE NO. 2023-22

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROVE 2023 REPLACEMENT PAGES TO THE CENTERBURG CODIFIED ORDINANCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Municipality and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessary for the earliest publication and distribution of current Replacement Pages to the officials and residents of the Municipality, so as to facilitate administration, daily operation and avoid practical and legal entanglements, therefore this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
