

ORDINANCE NO. 2016- OZ

**AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR
TO EXCEED SPENDING LIMIT AND SPEND UP TO \$80,000.00 TO
PURCHASE A NEW MUNICIPAL TRUCK WITH THE SNOW PLOW
AND DUMP PACKAGE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, the Village of Centerburg owns and operates two dump trucks with snow equipment that are utilized to keep the streets and alleys of the Village clear of snow and ice, as well as for other Village maintenance and repair purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator and staff have determined that the secondary and older of the two dump trucks is no longer viable for safe municipal work, and that the cost to replace the existing truck and the benefits of fewer maintenance costs and more efficient operations mandate that the Village purchase a new dump truck; and

WHEREAS, the sudden failure of the dump truck necessitates immediate replacement to ensure proper operations of Village maintenance activities; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Revised Code Section 731.14 and 731.141, the Village Administrator, on behalf of the Village, may enter into a contract exceeding \$50,000.00 when the contract is for equipment or supplies to be purchased under Revised Code Sections 125.04 (State agency purchasing) and/or 5513.01 (State Department of Transportation purchasing); and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has obtained a proposal from Thomas Garage, Inc., with pricing in accordance with the aforementioned state purchasing programs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CENTERBURG, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Village Administrator is hereby authorized to exceed his spending limit for a one time purchase up to a total expenditure not to exceed \$80,000.00 to Thomas Garage, Inc., or any of its subsidiaries, to purchase a 2015 Dodge Ram 5500 C&C Cab A truck pursuant the aforementioned state-authorized pricing programs as quoted in the March 3, 2016 purchase order, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare, such emergency arising out of the need to address immediate maintenance, utility, and repair needs in the Village, and to ensure welfare by promptly securing a vehicle, the availability of which is limited, that serves the Village's needs pursuant to the state-authorized pricing programs.

WHEREFORE, this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage and approval by the Mayor.
